The closing date for applications is Monday 18th March. Videos will be sent to you in March to allow you to learn Rhyme & Sign ahead of the training course.

There are spaces on the course for a maximum of 8 people so early booking is advised. Priority will be given to people planning to use Bible Alive in schools.

The training course will include demonstrations and practice in various story telling techniques as well as a advice on putting together a Bible Alive programme, planning lessons, and communicating effectively with schools.
