Where are we now?

Over the last year, the Independent Schools ministry has benefited from the faithful financial support of over 50 donors. However, while regular giving has risen slightly, one-off donations have fallen sharply. The graph below summarises income for this ministry over the past three years, and highlights the current shortfall in regular giving.



Where are we going?

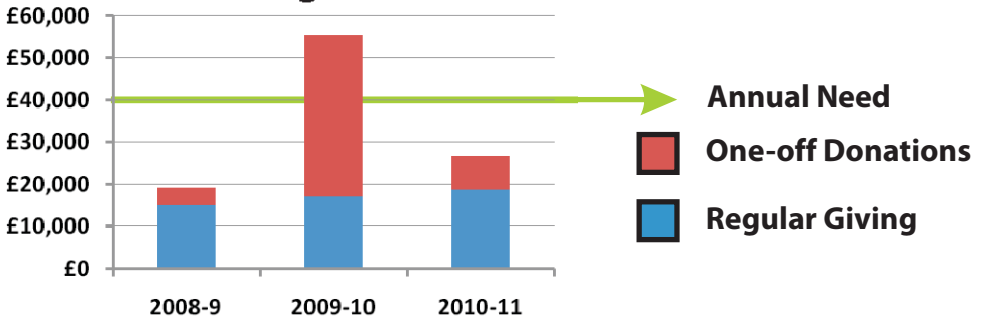
In the past, IS ministry has enjoyed the luxury of some reserve funding. However, these funds have depleted and the ministry is depending on the General Fund to survive.

How will we get there?
