Everyone attends a training event where you are helped to recognise your potential and work out the right kind of events (holidays, missions or weekends) for your placement, where you'll live out the COMMISSION adventure. Gather with everyone at the end of the summer for a massive weekend celebration and review to share amazing stories of how God has changed lives – including yours!

TRAINING



Each Basecamp event equips you for the role of Trainee Leader. Bible teaching, workshops, team building, small groups, worship and prayer will all help you prepare to work amongst Scotland's children and young people.

Are you 18+ or a Basecamp graduate? Choose LeadUP, a more advanced week of training that encourages you to develop reflective skills and consider your contribution to teams you are part of. Quality Bible teaching, an emphasis on helping you to grow as a young Christian leader as well as seminars, workshops and a team building day to prepare you for the role you will play in working with young people at SU Scotland events.



"I attended LeadUP this year and loved it. I learnt a lot about working in teams and the different roles I take on depending on group dynamics. Alongside practical skills, the evening teaching was great at going 'back to basics', challenging me to come back to the cross daily. "Basecamp is a great transition from camper to leader. You are treated as an adult and never patronised, but at the same time there are a team of leaders giving focussed and clear support, as well as ensuring you have fun! I was certainly challenged – there were days where I felt quite scared at the thought of leading children – but that was good. There was a powerful sense of being equipped."
