The course will begin with lunch at 1:00pm on Tuesday 28th August and finish with lunch on Friday 31st August. Accommodation will be provided in small bunk-bedded rooms.

Cost: £199 (includes training manual, Rhyme & Sign DVD, accommodation and all meals)

The closing date for applications is Wednesday 25th July.

A DVD will be sent to you in July to allow you to learn Rhyme & Sign ahead of the training course.

There are spaces on the course for a maximum of 8 people so early booking is advised. Priority will be given to people planning to use Bible Alive in schools.

The training course will include demonstrations and practice in various story telling techniques as well as advice on putting together a Bible Alive programme, planning lessons and communicating effectively with schools.



Lendrick Muir is owned by Scripture Union and is situated near Kinross. It is easily accessible by car, or by Citylink coach to Kinross Park and Ride. Transport from Kinross to the centre can be provided.
