A STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE

We love to celebrate at SU Scotland!

Whether it's reaching our target of 500 SU Groups in schools, or the one new group that started in our local primary. It might be the 2,000 young people that went to SU Holidays this summer, or that one kid who went for the first time and loved it! Any excuse to gather together, celebrate and get excited about what God is doing through SU Scotland!

Could you join with us and host your own "wee celebration" in your home, neighbourhood or church to raise money for SU Scotland and promote our work with children and young people? It could be a pizza party, afternoon tea, curry night or coffee morning. We want to support you to be as creative as you like and plan an event which suits you!

Here is our step-by-step guide for your very own Wee Celebration.

1. Pick your event

Are you a budding MasterChef or star baker? Are you a cook-everything-from-scratch type or do you have your local takeaway on speed dial?! You can serve up whatever you like at your wee celebration or even just organise a bake stall at your church, school or office.

2. Choose a time and place

Choose a date and a venue that suits you. There is no pressure to hold it by a certain date, though it would be great if you could hold your event by the end of November.

3. Promote your event

Using the poster or invitation templates on suscotland.org.uk/weecelebration, insert the date, time and place to advertise your wee celebration; edit the downloadable PowerPoint slide to promote your event in church and don't forget to publicise it on Social Media too!

4. Don't go it alone

Whatever shape your event is taking, whether at home, in church or elsewhere, invite others to use their gifting to help you!



5. Plan your recipes

We have included some recipes in our wee celebration packs, which you may find useful if you're going down the baking route. You may have your own favourites (your Granny's famous Rock buns?!) or you could even adventure on to Pinterest for some new ideas!

6. Decorate your space

It's a celebration after all, so use our balloons (more available on request) to add colour to your event. We've also included some stickers for branding up your bake stall or giving away to your younger guests!

7. Take pictures (and video)

Photograph your displays! Share photographs on your social media site – and don't forget to tag **#weecelebration**; for the adventurous, record a short video! We love supporter stories like this.

8. Share the Joy

Your Wee Celebration is a great opportunity to share what SU Scotland does with your guests, so we've included introductory leaflets about our ministry in the wee celebration packs. (Let us know if you need more.)

9. Money, money, money

Use the *Donate Here* sign to show people where to give, and the ribbon included in your pack to decorate jar(s) for donations.

10. Continue the Celebration

Share good news! Let your friends know how much was raised by your wee celebration.
