JOB PURPOSE:

PRIMARY WORKING RELATIONSHIPS

Internal: Alltnacriche staff team, Schools teams at Lendrick Muir and Gowanbank.

External: Centre users, volunteers, local community

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

Create a safe and welcoming environment for guests.

- Provide a high level of customer service and model this to other members of the Alltnacriche staff team
 - Play an active role in the bookings process, taking ownership of assigned tasks, to maintain and develop relationships with centre users
 - Ensure relevant guest information is communicated in a timely and appropriate manner to other members of the Alltnacriche staff team
- Welcome guests to the centre and act as host during their stay
 - Be a consistent point of contact for guests visiting or staying at the centre
 - Act as an advocate for the needs of the guests and those using the centre, by communicating these effectively with the relevant members of the Alltnacriche team
- Maintain an active awareness of the resource available for delivery of our programmes at the centre
 - Practice effective time management to be able to balance delivery of ministry sessions and instructor-led activities
 - Communicate issues with resource management effectively, and act as an advocate for the needs of the Alltnacriche staff team

Deliver and develop ministry opportunities to young people

> Grow and develop the ministry opportunities in the centre's outdoor programmes to young people

- Working closely with the Ministry Development Coordinator, play an active role in developing and reviewing the ministry programmes at Alltnacriche
- Develop an understanding of current educational and youth work best practice to be able to develop high quality session content

Deliver the centre's ministry programmes

- Deliver high quality sessions to guests, appropriate to their age, background and needs, and which reflect the aims and values of Scripture Union Scotland
- Model delivery of high quality ministry sessions to other members of the Alltnacriche team

Play an active role in promoting the centre to new and existing centre users to create opportunities for ministry

- Develop an awareness of the marketing strategy for Alltnacriche, realising the aims and vision of the centre, taking responsibility for one area of marketing and developing our marketing content in this area
- Promote the wider work of Scripture Union Scotland to those visiting the centre

Support delivery of high-quality activity sessions

> Be responsible for an agreed area of equipment maintenance and development.

- Ensure checks routine checks on area of responsibility are carried out, in line with centre requirements.
- Ensure effective and appropriate communications about area of responsibility.
- Ensure that any required action is taken to remedy issues or to develop area of responsibility.

Deliver high quality activity sessions to centre users.

- Ensure style of delivery reflects the aims and values of Alltnacriche.
- Champion the integration of ministry programmes and outdoor activity sessions
- Deliver activity sessions in accordance with the Alltnacriche safety management system.

Maintain Competency and engagement with training.

- Be responsible for ensuring that technical qualifications are valid, with up to date and logged experience.
- Engage with all required centre training, contributing where necessary.
- Be responsible for personal and professional growth, identifying personal training needs and creating actions plans to ensure that these needs are well met.

In Common with all Alltnacriche team members

> To participate fully in the life and ministry of Alltnacriche including:

- Attend and take a share in leading staff prayer and Bible study.
- Build partnerships with existing and potential supporters to encourage prayer, giving and volunteering support for your specific role and the wider ministry of SU Scotland as appropriate to your role.
- Contribute to Alltnacriche Prayer News

Assist with daily operation of the centre

- Deliver activity sessions
- Assist with cleaning
- Act as duty staff, providing the first point of contact for guests (on a rotational basis).

IN COMMON WITH ALL SCRIPTURE UNION SCOTLAND EMPLOYEES:

- Further the aims and objectives of SU Scotland;
- Undertake personal development through active participation in annual work reviews, supervision and identified training (internal, external or other) as required;
- Take part in other SU Scotland activities where appropriate;

- Demonstrate commitment to the SU Scotland ethos, vision, values and work practices, and the wider ministry of SU in Scotland and beyond.
- To build partnerships with existing and potential supporters to encourage prayer, financial giving and
 volunteering support for your specific role and the wider ministry of SU Scotland. The means of doing
 this will be tailored according to the nature of your role and personal circumstances and an action
 plan agreed with your line manager
