# **Explore Christmas**

is a free RME resource created by Scripture Union Scotland for first and second level learners in Scottish schools. In line with the curriculum, this resource will explore how and why Christians celebrate at this time of year.

The videos and supporting resource pack are easy to access and will provide engaging learning opportunities for pupils to develop their knowledge of Christian beliefs and practices. In addition to a series of three videos, there are a number of suggested cross curricular activities to allow the teacher to plan a more in-depth topic if desired.







The content of the videos are summarised below. These are designed to be watched in order with both first and second level learners. The supporting differentiated resources can be accessed by registering at suscotland.org.uk/explorechristmas.

The first episode explores where Christmas comes from and the why behind the celebration. The history of the Jewish people is presented, as is written in the Old Testament of the Bible and details how the people were waiting for a promised future king. Key Christian vocabulary such as 'prophesy' and 'Messiah' are introduced and are discussed in light of how they impact the Christian celebration today.

The Christmas season is often full of surprises and this episode explores the unexpected circumstances of the birth of Jesus, who Christians believe to be the promised King. The details of the nativity story are a key part of what Christians celebrate at Christmas and its impact is discussed in this episode. Key Christian vocabulary such as 'nativity' and 'Emmanuel' are introduced and explained.

The final episode in this series explores the concepts of hope, joy and peace and investigates why these are so important to the celebration of Christmas. Christians believe that the person of Jesus brings these values to humanity and this impacts a Christian's life choices and actions. Key Christian vocabulary of 'sin' and 'salvation' are explored, as is the concept of 'light' coming through a Messiah.
