

# **MOTIV8**

SU Scotland have been running residential events for young people for decades welcoming around 3,500 young people each year. Weekend events take place throughout the year, with longer events during the Easter, summer and October holidays.

Our activities are intended to excite, challenge and broaden young people's experience. They include skills like woodcarving, opportunities like walking in the Cairngorms and thrills like king swing and zip lines. Great food, good friends, caring leaders, time to explore the Bible and who Jesus is are features of every holiday.

We recognise that a standard SU Holiday for young people from Scotland's poorest communities may be one or two steps too far... we get that. That's why we have been delivering Motiv8 Holidays for more than 15 years offering the same life-changing time away, but with the extra support and more relaxed boundaries that young people may require.

SU Scotland's vison is to see every child and young person in Scotland exploring the Bible and responding to the significance of Jesus.

Our twin values of dependence on God and deepening relationships affect all ministry areas: growing meaningful relationships with churches, organisations, volunteers and crucially young people.

The Bible resounds with a commitment towards those who experience life at the margins. Partnering with local churches and youth projects, we are committed to giving significant focus and attention to young people whose life experience can mean fewer choices, resources and opportunities.

We want Motiv8 Holidays to be residential experiences for young people where they can grow in friendships and in faith.



### MOTIV8 HOLIDAYS?

We want to get it right for your young people and are more than happy to help you consider which type of event may be best.

Motiv8 Holidays are more suited to young people who may benefit from the following:

- A relaxed programme
- Realistic expectations around cultural norms, language and Bible engagement
- · Later bedtimes and morning start times
- Shorter length of residential

### HOW CAN WE ACCESS MOTIV8 HOLIDAYS?

Motiv8 Holiday Partners are individuals, local churches or youth projects who have year-round contact with young people in Scotland's poorest communities. In addition, Partners:

- Send at least one adult, known by the young people to be part of the Motiv8 Holiday team
- Can request places on standard SU
   Holidays for young people who will flourish
   within that environment, but for whom
   finance may be a barrier
- Are invoiced for the heavily subsidised cost of each young person attending a Motiv8 or standard SU Holiday, covering any financial shortfall a young person may experience
- Ensure that young people are able to get to any agreed transport organised



### **TEAM**

#### All Motiv8 Holidays:

- Are led by experienced and trained Team Leaders who have regular engagement with young people living life at the margins
- Provide a high ratio of team to young people, ensuring young people are well supported.

#### All Motiv8 Holiday team members:


- Go through the SU Scotland volunteer application process (including application, references and PVG)
- Serve under the event Team Leader, within the vision and values of SU Scotland
- Are asked to make a donation to the cost of the Motiv8 Holiday

### COST

One of the most significant challenges we anticipate for young people from priority communities is finance. We do not want cost to be a limiting factor.

Through the generosity of hundreds of people each year, the SU Holidays Sponsorship Fund significantly reduces the cost of a young person attending a Motiv8 or standard SU Holiday.

Even this amount is likely to be beyond some families, and so we ask the Partner to cover any deficit.
