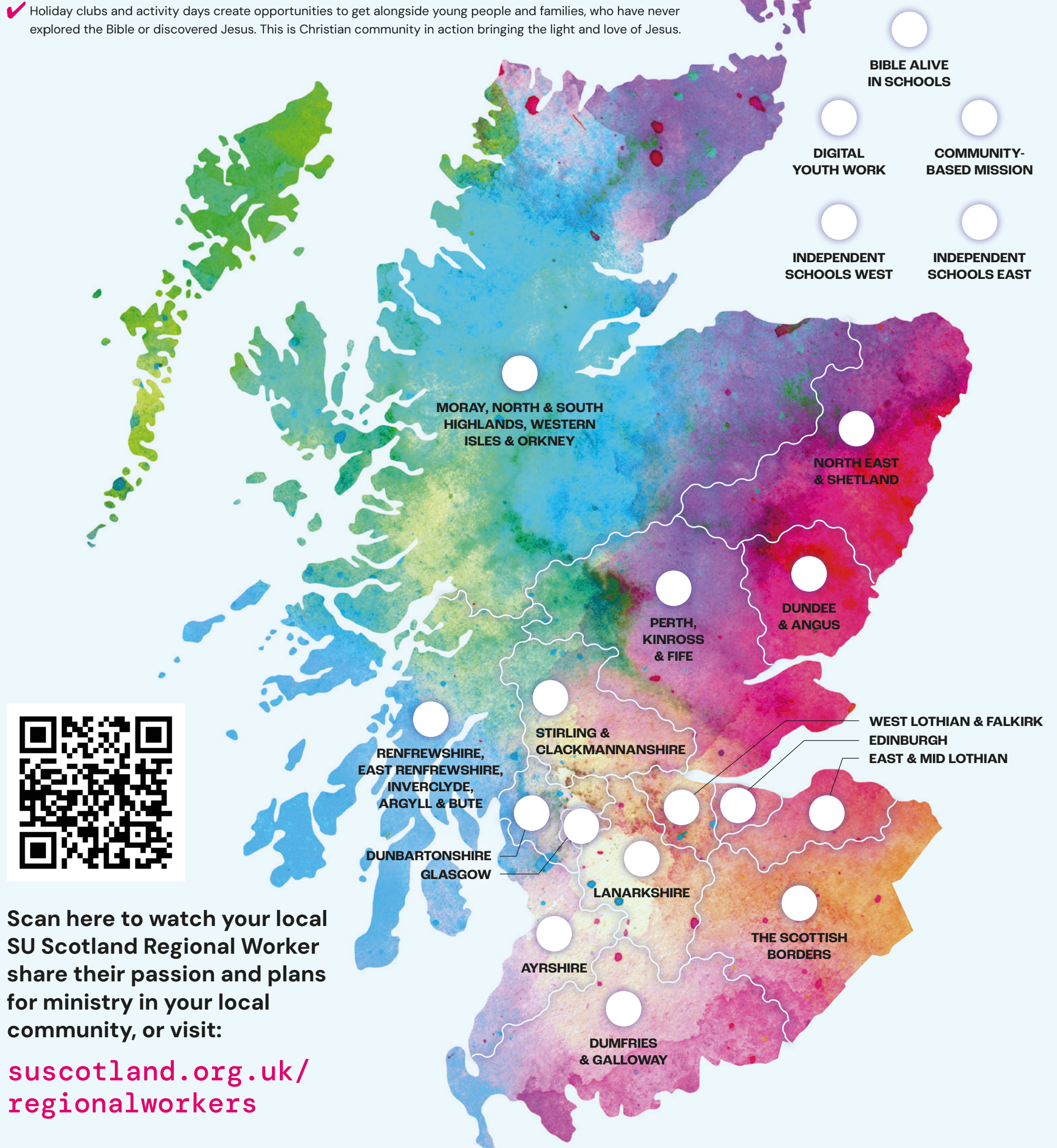

- ✓ Local Ministry Hubs are launching around every high school and its associated primaries—local Christians, churches and youth ministries are coming together to pray for and serve Scotland's young people.
- ✓ Bible Alive is an exciting opportunity for children to explore the Bible in their RME lessons. Children love this engaging, resource which takes them from Genesis to Revelation using storytelling, drama, music and British Sign Language.
- ✓ The Local Ministries Team believe residential transform lives through our regional weekend events. These events are action packed, full of activities, Bible teaching and lots of fun!
- ✓ At our Equip events, we help young people live for Jesus in school, at home and in their communities. We have fun, with worship, Bible teaching and a Q&A panel. Young people grow in confidence in God as we discuss life's big questions.
- ✓ Holiday clubs and activity days create opportunities to get alongside young people and families, who have never explored the Bible or discovered Jesus. This is Christian community in action bringing the light and love of Jesus.

We want to make the experience of Ben, Katie and Lochlan* available in every school in Scotland. We build SU Groups, disciple and train young leaders through our Equip programme, lead RME lessons and school assemblies. We host regional weekends, holiday clubs and community-based missions. Our Bible Alive programme is experienced by thousands of pupils across the country. We have a clear vision to establish 360 Local Ministry Hubs, offering these activities at the heart of every high school cluster with its associated primary schools.

150 of the 360 high school clusters (with their associated primaries) across Scotland are being served by our new Local Ministry Hubs. These Hubs meet regularly to pray for our schools and to grow collaborative ministry opportunities in schools and surrounding local communities.



Each week, about 4,530 pupils attend our 377 SU Groups. 80 new SU Groups have been launched since August 2024.



In December we made over 12,000 connections with pupils in schools across the country through delivery of interactive Christmas lessons and assemblies, many hearing about Jesus for the first time. We made another 8,500 connections at Easter.



Bible Alive was delivered in 72 schools in the last academic year, with 3,450 pupils participating, and in more than half of the council regions across Scotland.

Young people are hungry to learn and grow in their faith and to live for Jesus in school. We were filled to capacity at our GO Conference for senior pupils last October. We meet up with around 400 high school pupils at our monthly discipleship events across the country.



We've seen growth in the number of senior pupils keen to lead their school SU Groups, with 46 trained during this last year.



36 Holiday Clubs as well as a number of activity days are running over the Easter, Summer and October holidays in 2025—brilliant opportunities to be getting alongside 1,500 children and their families, in partnership with local churches.



1,250 children and young people have attended our regional weekends so far this year, during which many campers gave their lives to Jesus. Residentials really do transform young lives!
